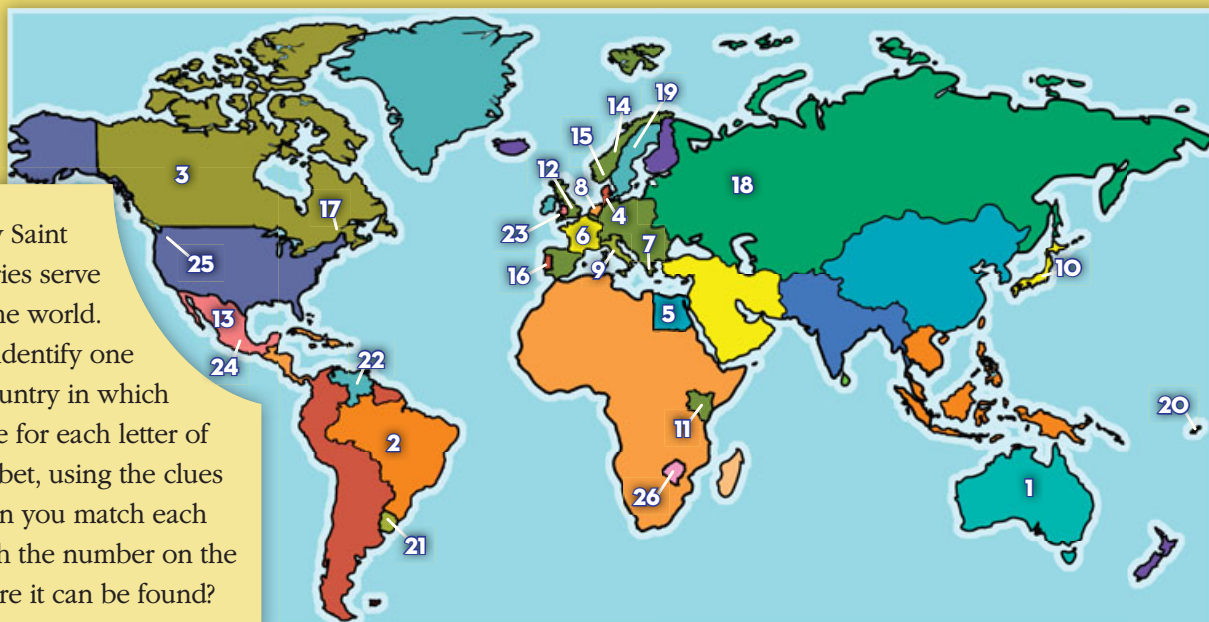


Missionary Roll Call
